2025 Championship Year National Invitational 55 & Over Mixed Doubles March 13-15, 2026, Phoenix, AZ

Eligibility & Team Rosters

Players: Each team must have a minimum of six (6) players (3 men & 3 women) providing for three courts of mixed doubles in the league level specified throughout the entire championship. Teams are expected to bring enough qualified players to field all three courts for every court of every team match. A maximum of 18 players may register and participate in the 55XNI.

- For 6.0 teams: 2.5, 3.0 and 3.5 rated players may participate. Mixed doubles pairings (one man and one woman) may not exceed 6.0.
- For 7.0 teams: 3.0, 3.5, and 4.0 rated players may participate. Mixed doubles pairings (one man and one woman) may not exceed 7.0.
- For 8.0 teams: 3.5, 4.0 and 4.5 rated players may participate. Mixed doubles pairings (one man and one woman) may not exceed 8.0.
- For 9.0 teams: 4.0, 4.5 and 5.0 rated players may participate. Mixed doubles pairings (one man and one woman) may not exceed 9.0.

Example: a team participating at the 7.0 level needs to have three courts with mixed doubles pairings at a combined NTRP level equal to 7.0 or lower. Players may only play up if there is an on-site injury or extenuating circumstances that require a team to play a player up a level to avoid defaulting a court.

Lineup Procedure: At the Mixed 55 & Over National Invitational only, when submitting a lineup, if a doubles line does not complete the NTRP level the team is competing in, the line must be placed at the lowest line. If the lineup is submitted incorrectly, the captain must re-submit.

Non-Playing Captain: A non-playing captain per team may attend. This captain must be the same captain that is listed in TennisLink.

Minimum Match Requirement: Players on teams advancing <u>from league play at the Section level and/or lower</u> must have played in at least 2 matches (1 default may count.)
