





# Captain's Responsibilities Highlights

- Organize team, make sure you have enough players on roster to fill the majority of courts for each team match, minimizing defaults. (communicate line ups, location, start times, etc.)
- Reserve and fulfill home court requirements
   Captains reserve their home courts
- Know and understand the regulations
- Confirm upcoming matches with opposing captains, designate staggered courts. HOME captain should reach out to visiting captain. But EITHER captain may initiate contact.
- Work with your opposing captain to reschedule and play make-ups and rain-outs.
- Play the majority of individual courts for each team match TTD, possible penalty/grievance
- Be familiar with hard closing times and time match rules. TMR sheet on Captains Corner.
- Enter scores and verify scores, but ANY PLAYER on roster may enter scores.
- Contact Kelly Ferris (<u>ferris@southwest.usta.com</u>) if any issues or questions arise

- Designate your team as "closed but seeking." This will allow interested and eligible players to have a message sent to the captain through tennislink. Captains can then reach out if they are interested in bringing the player on to their team.

### Players on Roster:

Players must be registered and listed on roster prior to playing in first match. Possible DQ for match if not. Don't learn the hard way.

- > Membership
- ➤ Eligibility calendar year age
- > "At Level" regulation 50%

MOST IMPORTANT: Captains must fill the majority of the individual courts each week. Total Team Default: majority of individual courts not played. Defaulting team is subject to a grievance and further penalties.

# Line Ups and Entering Scores

Winning team captains enter scores from the point of view of the winner within 24 hours following team match completion.

- Opposing captain logs in and confirms scores.
   Scores not confirmed by captain will autoconfirm 48 hours following initial entry.
- Timed match or retirement scores only enter the games that were actually played.
- A SET tie break counts as one game.
   A MATCH tie break counts as one set AND one game.
- Score disputes recommended that captain text opposing captain scores. Reply confirmation.

Staggered Start times:

- Visiting captain designates which earlier courts will play earlier start times.
   Notify home captain 48 hours or more in advance. If visiting captain does not inform home captain 48 hours or more in advance, the home captain may make those designations.
- Only exchange line ups for the courts about to start. Possible injury or issue on the way to courts for last matches.

How should we exchange line ups? Does it have to be on paper? No it doesn't have to be on paper but it is a best practice. Alternatively, captains can text each other their line ups – in order.

After line up exchanged, can it be changed?

- If an unknown default occurs and other courts have not started, re-do both line ups
- If a player is injured in warm up & another registered teammate is there to play.

Play the tennis that has been scheduled for you and your players. Don't default courts. Don't rob others of the tennis they signed up for!

# Bumped Players and Fall ES Season

### NEW!!!

If a player is "bumped up" at year end (Dec 1) to a level <u>higher</u> than the level they are currently playing, they may finish playing the regular fall season – but no post season play: no flight playoffs, no District, Section, or National Championships UNLESS the player receives notification of "Clearly Above Level." CAL notices are sent to all CAL players and their captains.

For combined ratings leagues (all mixed leagues, 55 & Over) a player may participate in listed championships IF paired with a player that keeps combined NTRP at level (or below.)

Thou Shalt Not Default.

### IMPORTANT REMINDERS

### Hard Closing Times:

Home Captain's Responsibility to know & inform prior to match Either Captain may declare Timed Match Rules (TMR.) If neither team elects to utilize TMR, the visiting players of any incomplete courts must travel to original facility for reschedule and match completion (or may decide to retire.) If home Captain fails to inform visiting captain of hard closing time and "Timed Match Rules" options, the visiting team will choose the facility location for reschedule and match completion.

### Defaults:

Warm Up: Facilities are not required to provide courts for league matches prior to the match start time. Warm up is NOT practice. Warm up is 10 minutes ONLY including serves. It goes fast!

Known defaults must be recorded on the lowest line first. D3 before D2, S2 before S1, etc. DO NOT PLAY a match if a default has already been declared. All matches played regardless of start time shall stand.

Facility Protocols: Captains and players are responsible for understanding & following any facility policies and restrictions.

### Playoffs for Fall Season:

Last date to complete all matches and Fall Playoff schedule is posted on the Captains Corner. Playoffs explained in 6.00 of our USTA Phoenix regulations. "Determination of Season Winners."

MOST IMPORTANT: Play the tennis. Fill the courts!!

### Rain-outs and Re-Schedules:

- **GET IT RE-SCHEDULED** and "on the books" within 7 **days** of the original match date. All reschedules/rainouts must be completed by the "last match date" on playoff schedule. Deadlines vary by league/flight.
- EMAIL me new date/time & copy opposing captain. I will update tennislink.
- HOLD all individual court scores until all lines are played. "Incomplete match"
- **REMINDERS** will be sent to captains if new date is **NOT** assigned in tennislink regarding over-due matches scores.
- RESCHEDULE date will be set by LLC IF both captains do not meet deadline for match re-schedule.
- KEEP written records of rescheduling efforts and offers to reschedule. It may come in handy.

Am I required to reschedule a match if an opposing captain requests?

No.

But LLC can mandate it under certain circumstances. Also, remember the Golden Rule

### 2024 Regulation Changes

### ➤ National Championship Format:

All 40 & Over Sectional Championship teams will play the following format at Nationals: 1 singles & 4 doubles this requires 9 players

### Membership

Individuals shall only have one USTA membership account/ USTA number. Individuals who obtain more than one USTA membership account/ USTA number may be subject to a grievance and such suspension penalties as outlined under the League Suspension Point System.

- Mixed Doubles NTRP Options Any Mixed Doubles local league, playoff, or championship matches may utilize Straight NTRP OR Combined NTRP – at the League Coordinator's or Tournament Director's discretion.
- Championships All Combined NTRP leagues pairings must be within .5 of the level of the league level.

### > Retirements

2.03M Retirement. A retirement occurs when an individual match has started and a player/doubles team is unable to continue due to injury, loss of condition, emergency, or refusal to play. If a full team retirement or combination of defaults and retirements occurs, the Championship Committee has the authority to file a grievance and to follow 2.03O if authorized by the Section. The Sectional Association may impose further penalties on the defaulting team. If such penalties include a suspension from League play, they must follow the League Suspension System, including the filing of a grievance and assessment of suspension points (See Regulation 3.03A(7) and 3.03D(4)).

### ► Unforeseen Circumstances.

Should any situation occur, which could potentially result in invalid matches or the postponement, rescheduling, or cancellation of a National Championship, a committee composed of the Tournament Director, National staff and National League Committee member(s) will determine the best course of action. This may include, but not be limited to, changes to the format, number of matches, and scoring. In certain extreme situations, National Co-Champions may be awarded. Sections may add additional language to their regulations or Championship Procedures to cover similar unforeseen circumstances.

### **KNOW** YOUR PLAYERS' RATING TYPES

To advance to <u>District</u> and <u>Section</u> Championships rostered players must play on *each* team in *each* season of play the following number of times.

- Computer rated "C" players: TWO (2) MATCHES and ONE DEFAULT MAY COUNT Nationals = 3 matches 1 default
- Mixed Exclusive "M" or "T" players: TWO (2) MATCHES and ONE DEFAULT MAY COUNT
   Nationals=3 matches 1 default
- Self "S" and Appeal "A" rated players: THREE (3) MATCHES and NO DEFAULTS COUNT Nationals = 4 matches NO DEFAULTS

Retirements count as "played." Retirement score change/correction allowed within 48 hours of match.

Defaults: bad Don't be bad. Tennis is a game that *requires* cooperation and courtesy. Courtesy is *expected*.

Benefit of the Doubt — ANY doubt WHATSOEVER regarding line-calls goes to opponent. A player should always give the opponent the benefit of the doubt. When a match is played without officials, the players are responsible for making decisions, particularly line calls. There is a subtle difference between player decisions and those of an on-court official. An official impartially resolves the problem involving a call, whereas a player is guided by the principle that any doubt must be resolved in favor of the opponent.

A player in attempting to be scrupulously honest regarding line calls frequently will keep a ball in play that might have been out or that the player discovers too late was out. Even so, the game is much better played this way. Un-officiated matches

### Scrupulously:

**1: having high moral integrity**: acting in strict regard for what is considered right or proper.

It is each player's responsibility to accept the calls from the other side of the court. Asking "are you sure" is fine, but the call shall be accepted after that.

### What's the Call?

- We are in the middle of a point, and I hear a cell phone ring from where all our bags are sitting. I stop the point and claim a hindrance. But then after checking, I realize it was my phone ringing. Do we play a let?
- No. You lose the point. Player whose phone rings, loses the point.
  - Can I call a foot fault on my opponent? He always does it and it drives me NUTS!!
  - Maaaaaybe, but be warned. These are un-officiated matches. A foot fault can be called <u>only after all</u> reasonable efforts have been made to stop the footfaults, such as multiple warnings/reminders. Also – good luck having a pleasant match after calling a fault.
    - I so totally saw the ball bounce twice before my opponent hit it back. I stopped the point and claimed it. She said she got to it before the 2<sup>nd</sup> bounce. Can I take the point?
    - No. Only the player can call a double bounce on herself.

- The ball landed close to the line and I'm not sure if it touched the line or not. I called it out, then offered to play a let. My opponent said the point is his. Is he right?
- Yes he is. It is his point. There was clearly doubt about the ball hitting the line. This means the point goes to your opponent.
  - We forgot what the score was. Can I ask spectators for help?
  - No. only on-court players can resolve disagreements. Correct issues that are discovered and continue playing. Score disagreement, go back to where you agreed and continue forward.
    - I hit a lob and yelled loudly for my partner to get back. Our opponent stopped play and claimed the point due to hindrance. Can she do that?
    - Yes. You yelled as the ball was traveling towards your opponent.

### What's the Call?

- The server's partner was off the court fetching a ball. The server begins her service motion. We stopped her because her partner was not there. Could I have returned the ball and played the point?
- Yes, you could have. But it was nice of you to let your opponent know. Good sportsmanship!
  - My opponent has a towel on the ground at the back of the court. Can I make them move it?
  - Yes have them hang it on the side of the court.
    - My opponent touched the net after a volley before the point was over. I stopped and claimed the point. She said she didn't touch the net and the point is hers because I stopped the point. Can she do that?
    - Yes, while she may not be truthful about touching the net while the ball was in play, she must call that on herself. You can tell her what you saw, but if she doesn't call it on herself, it's her point.
  - My shoe came off, but we kept playing. I won the point. My opponent said she gets the point because she was hindered. Is it her point?
  - No, you continued to play and won the point. It is your point.

- My partner hit me in the head with his first serve. Do we get another first serve?
  - No, only a 2<sup>nd</sup> serve.
    - My opponent hit a big first serve and hit my doubles partner in the foot before it bounced. He was standing outside the service box. Our opponent tried to take the point, but we convinced him to play a let. Was that correct?
    - No, you should have given him the point. It doesn't matter where a player is standing, if the serve hits his body or racquet before bouncing, the point goes to the server.
      - I was talking to my partner before my serve. The returner decided to run around the entire court before my first serve of the game. It was not a change over. Can she do that?
      - No. Players are not permitted to step on their opponents' court after the match starts. Reasonably, a player may crossover to fetch a nearby stray ball.
- Can a player in a sport wheelchair play league tennis? Yes – they get 2 bounces. The 2<sup>nd</sup> bound can be
- Yes they get 2 bounces. The 2<sup>nd</sup> bound can be anywhere. All players not in a sport chair get one bounce.
